NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election of the qualified voters of the Coram Fire District (hereinafter called the "Fire District"), in the Town of Brookhaven, Suffolk County, New York, will be held at the Coram Fire District building located at 303 Middle Country Road, Coram, New York, 11727, in said Fire District, on Tuesday, March 5, 2019. The polls shall open at 3:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) and shall remain open until 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) or as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their votes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Fire District on January 22, 2019, the following Proposition will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Fire District for approval or disapproval:

PROPOSITION

SHALL the bond resolution of Coram Fire District, in the Town of Brookhaven, New York, entitled: "BOND RESOLUTION OF THE CORAM FIRE DISTRICT ("FIRE DISTRICT"), IN THE TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JANUARY 22, 2019, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION AND ALTERATIONS TO THE EXISTING STATION 2 FIREHOUSE FACILITY LOCATED ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF PINE ROAD AND ROUTE 112, IN CORAM, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN A PLAN PREPARED FOR THE FIRE DISTRICT BY MARTIN F. SENDLEWSKI, A.I.A. ARCHITECT-PLANNER, RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF ORIGINAL FURNISHINGS, EQUIPMENT, MACHINERY OR APPARATUS AND ANY ANCILLARY OR RELATED SITE, DEMOLITION AND OTHER WORK REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH ("PROJECT"); STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS NOT TO EXCEED \$2,975,000, INCLUDING PRELIMINARY COSTS AND COSTS INCIDENTAL THERETO AND TO THE FINANCING THEREOF; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE, INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$150,000 FROM THE EXISTING "BUILDING CAPITAL RESERVE FUND" HERETOFORE ESTABLISHED, WHICH IS HEREBY APPROVED; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE FIRE DISTRICT IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$2,825,000 TO FINANCE THE BALANCE OF SAID APPROPRIATION; DETERMINING THAT THE PERIOD OF PROBABLE USEFULNESS OF SAID PROJECT IS TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS; DETERMINING THAT, PURSUANT TO THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT ("SEQRA"), THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, ACTING AS LEAD AGENCY, HAS DETERMINED THAT THE PROJECT IS AN UNLISTED ACTION AND A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN ISSUED AND FILED AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES TO BE COLLECTED TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS," BE APPROVED?

All residents of the Fire District who were duly registered to vote with the Suffolk County Board of Elections on or before February 11, 2019, shall be eligible to vote at said Special Election.
