

RATTMER'S 3 TDS SPARK LONGWOOD

SUFFOLK I

Noah Rattmer threw for 237 yards and three touchdowns in No. 4 Longwood's 35-28 victory over No. 5 Commack in a Suffolk I quarterfinal on Friday night. Rattmer found Zach Soriano twice in the fourth quarter for touchdowns to give Longwood (6-3) the edge.

The two connected for a 59-yard touchdown with 9:30 left in the fourth that gave Longwood a 27-21 lead. A minute and a half later, they teamed up for a 61-yard touchdown that pushed the Longwood lead to 34-21. Soriano caught four passes for 166 yards and two touchdowns. Kyle Rausch ran for 83 yards on seven carries.

Elijah Stokley led Longwood with nine tackles, a sack, and a fumble recovery.

Ward Melville 42, Whitman 0: Trey Berry had four rushes for 86 yards and a touchdown and completed 4 of 4 passes for 64 yards and two touchdowns to lead No. 2 Ward Melville (8-1) over No. 7 Whitman on Friday night.

Nick Troy added nine carries for 66 yards and a touchdown. JJ Laap had two interceptions for the Patriots, returning one 85 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter.

Floyd 42, Central Islip 0: Mack Driver threw for two touchdown passes and rushed for another score in top-seeded Floyd's victory over No. 8 Central Islip on Saturday.

His 67-yard touchdown pass to Devin Brown with 1:12 left in the first quarter gave Floyd a 20-0 lead. Driver's 73-yard run with 11:30 left in the second put the Colonials ahead 27-0. Zion Wellington rushed five times for 97 yards, much of which came on an 83-yard touchdown run. Mike Tarrey and PK Kite each had sacks for Floyd (9-0).

Tallarico lifts N. Babylon

SUFFOLK II

Makhi Tolliver forced a fumble on the Northport 4-yard line with 30 seconds left that was recovered by Ross Tallarico, preserving the 18-13 win for No. 6 North Babylon (5-4) over No. 3 Northport in a Suffolk II quarterfinal on Saturday.

Tallarico scored on a 22-yard touchdown run that put the Bulldogs ahead with two minutes left in the game. Justin Gerdvil gave Northport a 13-12 lead with a 9-yard rush with 9:30 left. Tallarico ran for 121 yards and a touchdown on 13 carries, while Dylan Diaz added 102 yards and a TD on 25 carries. Craig Jackson had 72 yards on 11 carries. Jackson also had a 7-yard touchdown in the third quarter to make it 12-7.

Centereach 33, Bellport 14: Alex Goldberg, on the first play of the game, threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to Liam Webber, sparking No. 4 Centereach over No. 5 Bellport on Friday night. Centereach rushed for 287 yards as a team. Matt Robbert, Devin Demetres and Eric Harrington each scored on rushing touchdowns of 8, 5, and 16 yards, respectively. Demetres rushed 14 times for 115 rushing yards.

West Islip 63, Smithtown West 27: Tim Weber ran for 273 yards and two touchdowns on 12 carries and Dominic Sagginario added 166 yards and a touchdown on nine carries to lead No. 1 West



Lindenhurst's Mike Anderson ran for a touchdown and caught a pass for another as the Bulldogs defeated Smithtown East, 35-7.

Islip (9-0) over No. 8 Smithtown West on Saturday. Weber also threw a 13-yard touchdown pass. Mike LaDonna scored the first of

Justin Rivera's 24-yard touchdown catch from Kevin Decker with 3:09 remaining in the fourth quarter sealed the 21-10 win for No. 5 Kings Park over No. 4 East Islip in a Suffolk III quarterfinal on Friday night. Rivera also had 105 yards rushing and a touchdown, while also contributing a sack on defense.

Decker finished 18 of 23 for 150 yards and two touchdowns. Eric Cassar, Andrew Greer and Tom McAfee each had two sacks, and Tyler Kaman and Mark Ingraffia each had interceptions. Kings Park is 7-2.

Westhampton 41, Comsewogue 13: Jaden Alfano-St. John had 14 carries for 104 yards and a touchdown to lead No. 1 Westhampton (9-0) over No. 8 Comsewogue on Friday night. He also had a pick and a sack on defense. Liam McIntyre had 14 carries for 90 yards and three touchdowns. Tyler Nolan added 10 rushes for 104 yards and a touchdown for Westhampton, which scored 28 unanswered points in the second half.

Half Hollow Hills West 31, Miller Place 12: Dakim Griffin rushed for 48 yards and a score and caught a 54-yard touchdown pass to lead No. 2 Hills West past No. 7 Miller Place. Gerald Filardi threw for 135 yards and two touchdowns for Hills West (8-1).

SUFFOLK IV

Justin Vega rushed for 177 yards and two touchdowns on 19 carries and threw for two more touchdowns in No. 4 Babylon's 41-6 win over No. 5 Wyandanch in a Suffolk IV quarterfinal on Friday.

Vega's 1-yard touchdown run with 7:00 left in the second quarter gave Babylon a 20-0 lead. His 6-yard touchdown pass to Matt Moretti with 11:00 left in the third quarter extended the lead to 27-0.

Tim Hartigan caught four passes for 56 yards and a 22-yard touchdown pass that put Babylon on the score-

board in the first quarter. Eric Trapani made six tackles, including four for a loss and two sacks. Babylon is 6-3.

Mount Sinai 40, Bayport-Blue Point 13: Mike Sabella ran for 78 yards and two touchdowns on 14 carries, had two sacks and forced and recovered a fumble to lead No. Mount Sinai (9-0) over No. 8 Bayport-Blue Point on Friday night.
